President (Rob) - Introductions & outline the points of the meeting, Highlight the direction of AMBA

Treasurer / Assistant Treasurer (Mike / Jacqueline) - Budgets / Accounts etc.

- Role has been divided into 3 roles: Steph Deglan City, Jacqueline -Gaming Grants, Mike Pratt- Budgets, Accounts
- Mike reviewed the budget: Areas that have grown over the last 2-3 years due to inflation that will need discussion: Uniforms, Equipment/Fence Costs, Umpire Fees, Fencing Costs.
- Steph Deglan will take over Treasurer Role in the next few months and Mlke will continue to support the role over the next year.
- Batting cages can use some capital improvements and the gaming grant will help with this.

- NCCP- More coaches are taking advantage of these courses that are refunded by AMBA
- Alumni Program

VP1 (Chelsey - Interim) - Tournaments / Umpires / Discipline / Scheduling

- Offsetting each division's games so that players can also ump. Clinic for female umpires will be held in March if there is enough interest.
- Steph Deglan will prepare a spring schedule for all those not competing in an interlock. It is very important that coaches contact Steph Deglan and Melissa Dahlen if a game is canceled so we are not paying for fields and umps that we are not using.
- Tournaments Had great Donor support for our Midsummer Classic tournament. We seem to be having a hard time finding volunteers so and idea for next year would be to make the tournament smaller with fewer teams/divisions and hold the tournament at Ex Park where volunteer load can be shared. July 3-6 is the booked date for this tournament.
- Coaches Banquet will go over rules/expectations/discipline.

VP2 (Brad N.) - Presentation on templates for Tryouts / Coach selections / Training programs

- Evaluations process and how it needs to be improved. MSET program will help with this.
- Websites need to specify expectations of players/parents for rep teams and needs to include fees, time commitments, boundaries.
- Working on an organizational chart so that volunteers know what needs to be done and when. Johnny can also put this on the website so that parents will know dates ahead of time.
- 5U Blast ball has been a great introduction to Abbotsford Baseball and will hopefully build the coaches and players within our association.

Director #1 (Colin D.) - Blast Ball, Tee Ball, Mosquito (5u - 11u)

- Parents requisition to move up kids a division but for fall ball. Kids will stay in appropriate division and can be re-evaluated for spring.
- Move up the speed of the pitching Machine- Gradually do it over the season to prepare kids for summer ball (8U)
- MSET- was a great experience overall and provides some extra evaluation for summer seasons.
- High performance training in the winter for 13U and 15U for those players wanting to play Rep for spring.

Director #2 (Derek) - PeeWee / Bantam / Midget (13u-18u)

• Challenger ball: it great to see our teams out there helping with this. This will be communicated at the coaches banquet.

Director #3 (Joe M - Interim) - Equipment / Uniforms / Fields

• Fall ball uniforms will be ready on Monday. Having the organizational chart and closing registration early will help us not have to scramble for uniforms.

- Uniforms for house division we will know numbers by mid-February so it would be nice
 to hand out uniforms at the coaches banquet. At the banquet we would like to hand out
 the balls and game bags as well.
- Jenni oversees uniforms 18U would be nice to have the single season uniforms. 8U/9U keep branding for Angels and divide teams by colors. Would be nice to have a helper for Jenni as the uniforms are becoming a big job.
- We need more storage for the uniforms.
